The LCSD administration has been carefully monitoring the recommendations of the CDC and MSDH regarding social gatherings as it relates to graduation ceremonies for the Class of 2020. We have clearly heard from our 2020 seniors their desires for a traditional graduation ceremony and we want to respect this request. We believe this will provide our graduating students one last opportunity for normalcy in a year filled with disruption and trepidation. In an effort to provide a traditional graduation ceremony, the administration has rescheduled all LCSD graduation events for later dates. Formal graduation plans have been set for our schools as follows, with make-up dates listed as well:
